History

Timeline

- **1. Creation:** God creates the heavens, earth and people
- 2. The Fall: Adam and Eve choose to disobey God. Their sin brings death and separation from God. But God promises to send one who will strike the head of the evil one
- **3. Noah's Ark:** Evil continues to grow on the earth. God decides to bring judgment, but gives people the chance to be saved by getting into the ark
- **4. Tower of Babel:** People try to build their own way back to God- Instead God confuses their language
- 5. Life of Job

- **6. 2000 BC Abraham:** God calls Abraham from Ur
- 7. Covenant: God tells Abraham to leave his home and go to the place God shows him. God promises Abraham, land, a son and that through Abraham's descendants, all nations will be blessed
- 8. God miraculously allows Abraham to have a son, Issac, he will be the son of the promise
- 9. God changes the name of Isaac's son Jacob to Israel. His 12 sons will become the 12 tribes of the nation of Israel

- 10. One of Jacob's sons, Joseph is sold into slavery and taken to Egypt. Years later God uses him to help his family (Israel) during a famine by moving them to Egypt
- 11. After 400 years the Egyptians have forgotten Joseph and how he helped them. They make the people of Israel slaves and the people cry out to God for help
- **12. Moses:** God chooses to use **Moses** and his brother Aaron to deliver His people Israel from slavery after 10 plagues- He miraculously parts the Red Sea

- **13. Covenant:** God gives the law at Mt. Sinai and promises blessings if the people obey and curses if they don't
- 14. God allows Moses to die in the wilderness, and choses **Joshua** to lead the people into the Promise Land
- **15. Period of the Judges**: The people are supposed to live with God as their king, but instead everyone does what is right in his own eyes
- 16. God grants Israel's request for a king, but their first **king Saul** turns away from God

17. 1000 BC God makes David king, and gives him
a new heart that loves
God

1 Tool: Old Testament Timeline

- **18. Covenant:** God promises David that his descendant will always be on the throne
- 19. David's son **Solomon** becomes king and builds God's temple
- 20. Solomon's son does not love & follow God. Part of the kingdom rebels and Israel is divided into northern kingdom (Israel) & southern kingdom (Judah)
- 21. God sends prophets like Isaiah to Israel and Judah telling them to repent or face judgment

- **22. 722 BC Capture:** Israel's kings do not follow God, He allows them to be conquered by Assyria
- 23. 586 BC Exile: Judah also has not followed God faithfully, He allows them to be captured and taken to Babylonia
- 24. God sends the **prophet**Jeremiah to comfort Judah,
 after 70 years they will
 return to the land
- 25. God keeps His promise and the **people of Judah return and rebuild** but still they struggle to love and obey God fully
