The Revelation

Revelation is often viewed as one of the most challenging books of the Bible to understand. While other books are mostly describing past events, Revelation is describing a future very different from our current experience. And instead of focusing just on our physical world, Revelation takes us behind the scenes to the real world. Revealing the truth of a bigger spiritual battle between God, the source of all goodness and His evil enemy Satan (who masquerades as good). The book is written by the apostle John who was given this vision by Jesus and told to write it down. John is describing heavenly things with the best earthly images he has. There are many metaphors and symbolic images, the details of which may seem difficult to understand. But the overall point is clear: Jesus will defeat Satan and death. And He is coming back to earth to judge the world. This will happen at a time no one knows. When He returns every person who has ever lived will be resurrected to live forever in one of two places. It will be clear at the judgment that everyone has sinned and earned eternal separation from God. However, for those who are in Christ, the debt of their sin has been paid. They will go on to enjoy eternal life with Christ and the blessings He has earned for His kingdom. As we read, we should seek to understand more about who Jesus is and pray for God to show us which group we are in.
